# INITIATIVE MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO THE ELECTORS

The Attorney-General has summarized the proposed measure as follows:

VETERANS' WELFARE BOND ACT. Initiative measure adding Section 4 to Article XVI of Constitution. Declares that the California Veterans' Welfare Bond Act of 1921 authorizing the issuance and sale of state bonds to carry on operations of Veterans' Welfare Board in aiding California veterans to secure farms and homes, enacted by the Legislature in 1921 and signed by Governor, is approved, validated and made effective without publication by Secretary of State or further submission to the people; declares provisions of section self-executing and legislative action in furtherance thereof unnecessary, but not prohibited.

TO THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA:

We, the undersigned, registered, qualified electors of the State of California, residents of Mendocino County (or City and County), present to the Secretary of State this petition and hereby propose that the Constitution of the State of California be amended by adding a new section to Article XVI of said Constitution to be numbered 4, to read as hereinafter set forth in full, and petition that the same be submitted to the electors of the State of California for their adoption or rejection at the next succeeding general election or as provided by law.

The proposed amendment reads as follows:

Section 4. The California Veterans' Welfare Bond Act of 1921 (Statutes of 1921, Chapter 578), authorizing the issuance and sale of State bonds, to carry on the operations of the Veterans' Welfare Board in aiding California veterans to secure FARMS and HOMES, enacted by the forty-fourth session of the Legislature of the State of California, and signed by the Governor of the State of California, May 30th, 1921, is hereby approved, adopted, legalized, validated and made effective without publication by the Secretary of State or further submission to the people of the State of California. All provisions of this section shall be self-executing and shall not require any legislative action in furtherance thereof, but this shall not prevent such legislative action.
