The undersigned registered and qualified electors of the State of California, hereby propose a Law to be presented to the Legislature of the State of California at the next succeeding session repealing that certain Act of the Legislature of the State of California, known as the California Retail Sales Act of 1933, Chapter 1020, Statutes of 1933, passed by the Legislature July 26, 1933, approved by the Governor July 31, and effective August 1, 1933, and entitled: "An Act imposing a tax for the privilege of selling tangible personal property and for the privilege of furnishing, preparing or serving tangible personal property, providing for permits to retailers, providing for the levying, assessing, collecting, paying and disposing of such tax, making an appropriation for the administration hereof, prescribing penal-

ties for violations of the provisions hereof, and providing this act shall take effect immediately."
 The Attorney General has summarized the proposed measure as follows:
REPEALING SALES TAX. Initiative Measure to be submitted to Legislature. Repeals Act of Legislature known as California Retail Sales Tax Act of 1933, approved by Governor July 31, 1933, effective August 1, 1933 Chapter 1020 Statutes 1933, which Act imposed a tax for privilege of selling at retail, and of furnishing, preparing or serving, tangible personal property, provided for permits to retailers, and for assessment, collection and disposition of such tax, made an appropriation for administration of Act and prescribed penalties for violations thereof

"An act imposing a tax for the privilege of selling tangible personal property and for the privilege of furnishing, preparing or serving tangible personal property, providing for permits to retailers, providing for the levying, assessing, collecting, paying and disposing of such tax, making an appropriation for the administration hereof, prescribing penalties for violations of the provisions hereof, and providing this Act shall take effect immediately" is hereby repealed.
