SUBJECT: Hearing, NCEW v. Victor Lasky/NANA

We have scheduled a Freedom of the Press Committee hearing on the complaint of the National Conference of Editorial Writers v. Victor Lasky and the North American Newspaper Alliance. A complete file on the complaint to date will be mailed to you early next week.
