THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF CALIFORNIA HAS PREPARED THE FOLLOWING TITLE AND SUMMARY OF THE CHIEF PURPOSE AND POINTS OF THE PROPOSED MEASURE:

SCHOOLS: BUSSING FOR INTEGRATION. INITIATIVE.

Prohibits school districts from bussing students for purpose of integration without written permission of parent or guardian.

TO THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA:

We, the undersigned, registered, qualified electors of the State of California, residents of _____ County, (or City and County), present to the Secretary of State this petition, proposing to add Section 1010 to the Education Code, relating to school attendance, and petition that the same be submitted to the electors of the State of California for their adoption or rejection at the next succeeding General Election, or as provided by law. The following is a full and correct copy of the title and text of the proposed measure:

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1010 IS ADDED TO THE EDUCATION CODE, TO READ:

1010. NO GOVERNING BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL BUS ANY STUDENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF INTEGRATION WITHOUT THE WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN.
