

Dear Sir:

Pursuant to the provisions of section 3507 of the Elections Code, you are hereby informed that on this date we mailed to Mr. Walter C. Frame, as proponent, the following title and summary for a proposed initiative constitutional amendment.

SALARIES FOR ELECTIVE OFFICES. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. Amends constitution to require approval by majority vote at an election before the salary for any elective state, city, or county office can be increased. Reduces compensation for any such office on the effective date of the measure by twenty-five percent of any increase in the annual compensation for the office between December 31, 1970, and the effective date of the amendment.

You should note, and consider advising the county clerks, that this proposed initiative is identical to that previously submitted by Assemblyman Floyd L. Wakefield and the title prepared is identical to the one sent to you by our letter of August 11, 1971, for Assemblyman Wakefield's proposal. Therefore, county clerks in accepting signatures on the petitions on this proposition should take care to note the dates that the signatures are executed so that prior petitions are not utilized.

Enclosed herewith is a declaration of mailing thereof.
