May 12, 1978 is the last date which the petition may legally be filed. However, a petition filed on that date could qualify for a later election.

(If the Proponent files the petition with the county on a date prior to 5/12/78, the county has 5 working days from the filing of the petition to determine the total number of signatures affixed to the petition and to transmit this total to the Secretary of State.)

- d. Last day for county to determine number of qualified electors who have signed the petition, and to transmit certificate, with a blank copy of the petition to the Secretary of State Friday, 6/2/78*

(If the Secretary of State notifies the counties to determine the number of qualified electors who signed the petition on a date prior to 5/19/78, the last day is not later than the fifteenth day after the notification.)

- e. If the signature count is between 281,164 and 343,644 then the Secretary of State notifies counties using the random sampling technique to determine validity of all signatures.

Last day for county to determine actual number of all qualified electors who signed the petition, and to transmit certificate, with a blank copy of the petition to the Secretary of State Friday, 6/30/78*

(If the Secretary of State notifies the counties to determine the number of qualified electors who have signed the petition on a date prior to 6/2/78, the last day is not later than the thirtieth day after the notification.)

Pursuant to the provisions of sections 3503 and 3513 of the Elections Code, you are hereby informed that on this day we mailed to Joseph R. Gutheinz, Jr., Stephen T. Bentley, Alister McAlister and Mike D. Antonovich, as proponents, the following title and summary:

LIMITATION ON PUBLIC FUNDING FOR ABORTIONS - INITIATIVE STATUTORY AMENDMENT. Prohibits use of public funds in California for the purpose of obtaining or paying for an abortion, except where the pregnant woman's life is endangered as determined by a physician licensed by the State of California. This measure could be amended to further its purposes by a two-thirds roll call vote of the membership of each house of the Legislature. Financial impact: Indeterminate.

INITIATIVE MEASURE TO BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO THE VOTERS

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

TO THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF STATE OF CALIFORNIA

We, the undersigned, registered, qualified voters of California, residents of _____ County (or City and County), hereby propose additions to the Government Code, relating to abortion and petition the Secretary of State to submit the same to the voters of California for their adoption or rejection at the next succeeding general election or at any special statewide election held prior to that general election or otherwise provided by law. The proposed amendments (full title and text of the measure) read as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 21 (commencing with Section 7550) is added to Division 7 of Title 1 of the Government Code, to read:

Chapter 21. Use of Public Funds for Abortions

7550. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including, but not limited to, Chapter 7 (commencing with Section 14000) of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Welfare and Institutions Code, no public funds shall be used in the State of California for the purpose of obtaining or paying for an abortion, except where the pregnant woman's life is endangered as determined

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by a physician licensed under the provisions of Chapter 5 (commencing with Section 2000) of Division 2 of the Business and Professions Code.

This section may be amended to further its purposes by a statute which is passed in each house of the Legislature by a roll call vote entered in the journal, two-thirds of the membership concurring.
