 - c. Last day for county to determine total
number of signatures affixed to petition
and to transmit total to Secretary of
State Friday, 9/1/78

* Date adjusted for official deadline which falls on a Sunday.

+ IMPORTANT NOTE: This petition must be filed with the County Clerk or Registrar of Voters by May 4, 1978 to ensure that it will be verified by the county in time to qualify for the November 7, 1978 General Election. August 25, 1978 is the last date which the petition may legally be filed. However, a petition filed on that date could qualify for a later election.

(If the Proponent files the petition with the county on a date prior to 8/25/78, the county has 5 working days from the filing of the petition to determine the total number of signatures affixed to the petition and to transmit this total to the Secretary of State.)

- d. Last day for county to determine number of qualified electors who have signed the petition, and to transmit certificate, with a blank copy of the petition to the Secretary of StateSaturday, 9/16/78

(If the Secretary of State notifies the counties to determine the number of qualified electors who signed the petition on a date prior to 9/1/78, the last day is not later than the fifteenth day after the notification.)
Elections Code Section 3520(d), (e).

- e. If the signature count is between 281,164 and 343,644, then the Secretary of State notifies counties using the random sampling technique to determine validity of all signatures.

Last day for county to determine actual number of all qualified electors who signed the petition, and to transmit certificate, with a blank copy of the petition to the Secretary of State Monday, 10/16/78

(If the Secretary of State notifies the counties to determine the number of qualified electors who have signed the petition on a date prior to 9/16/78, the last day is not later than the thirtieth day after the notification.)

4. Campaign Statements:

Last day for Proponent to file a Campaign Statement of Receipts and Expenditures for period ending 9/22/78 Friday, 9/29/78

(If the Secretary of State finds that the measure has either qualified or failed to qualify on a date earlier than 8/25/78, the last date to file is the 35th calendar day after the date of notification by the Secretary of State that the measure has either qualified or failed to qualify. The closing date for this campaign statement is 7 days prior to the filing deadline.)



Pursuant to the provisions of sections 3503 and 3513 of the Elections Code, you are hereby informed that on this day we mailed to Alfred E. Alquist, as proponent, the following title and summary:

NUCLEAR GENERATION OF ELECTRIC POWER - INITIATIVE STATUTE. Authorizes, subject to the approval of federal agencies including the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the construction and operation of any proposed nuclear electric generating site and related facilities for which notice of intention to file an application for certification was filed with the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission prior to December 30, 1976. Expressly exempts such projects from the California Environmental Quality Act and the Warren-Alquist State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Act. Financial impact: Would result in a one-time savings to state agencies of approximately \$500,000 in personnel and operating expenses. The effect of this measure on state and local costs for energy is uncertain.

Enclosed herewith is a declaration of mailing thereof, and a copy of the proposed measure.

The provisions of Division 13 and 15 of the Public Resources Code shall not apply to any proposed nuclear electric generating site and related facilities for which a notice of intention, pursuant to Chapter 6, Division 15 of said code, was filed prior to December 30, 1976. Such facilities are hereby authorized to be constructed and operated in the State at such time as authorized and under such conditions as imposed by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission and other Federal agencies.
