I hereby request a title and summary of the proposed initiative, which follows:

Innocent human life is inviolable. It cannot be terminated, defiled, or destroyed with impunity under any circumstances.

I want this added to Section 1, Article 1 of the State Constitution.

It would look like this:

Article 1 Declaration of Rights


Section 1. All people are by nature free and independent and have inalienable rights. Among these are enjoying and defending life and liberty, acquiring, possessing, and protecting property, and pursuing and obtaining safety, happiness, and privacy.

Innocent human life is inviolable. It cannot be terminated, defiled, or destroyed with impunity under any circumstances.

Section 2. etc.


I, Richard L. Board declare under penalty of perjury that I am a citizen of the United States, 18 years of age or older, and a resident of Contra Costa county, California.

I, Richard L. Board, acknowledge that it is a misdemeanor under state law (Section 18650 of the Elections Code) to knowingly or willfully allow the signatures on an initiative petition to be used for any purpose other than qualification of the proposed measure for the ballot. I certify that I will not knowingly or willfully allow the signatures for this initiative to be used for any purpose other than qualification of the measure for the ballot.

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

HUMAN LIFE. INITIATIVE CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT. States that “innocent human life,” which is not defined, cannot be violated, terminated, defiled, or destroyed. Fiscal impact: **It is the opinion of the Legislative Analyst and Director of Finance that the measure may result in a substantial net change in state or local finances depending on how the initiative is interpreted and applied by the courts.** (14-0012.)
